15. One 4 One Prosecco 2 *Single Serve* £5.95  
Delicate and complex bouquet with fruity notes that remind of peach, green apple with second notes of acacia and lilac. Fresh and light on the palate, with balanced acidity and body; harmonic with a long persistent aftertaste.
16. Nua Prosecco 3 £19.95  
Nua is a premium Italian producer of the world famous Prosecco sparkling wine. This pale yellow sparkling wine is elegant and crisp, with a fruity bouquet of citrus and tropical fruits.
17. Nua Prosecco Sparkling Rosé 2 £19.95  
Beautiful sparkling pink from Italy. Dry, elegant with soft berry fruit - plus the bottle looks stunning too...! Fantastic.
18. François Montard (Method Traditional) 2 £20.95  
Wonderful aromas of white flowers and citrus fruit and fairly creamy and smooth taste with beautiful lingering aromas.
19. Jules Feraud Cuvée de Reserve Brut 1 £29.95  
A champagne from a co-operative of growers crafted this phenomenal champagne. A broad and fantastic panache which delivers beautifully.
20. Moët & Chandon Brut Imperial NV 1 £54.95  
A classic Champagne that everybody knows, delicately vinous, with a vine and lime blossom attack, a well balanced palate, a sense of harmony, mellowness.

## WHITE WINES

1. Louis Eschenauer Sauvignon Blanc £15.75  
*IGP D'Oc, France* 1 175ml £3.95  
 This pale yellow Sauvignon has a highly expressive nose with pineapples and exotic fruit which then deliver on the palate with undertones of lemon and grapefruit. 250ml £5.35
2. San Giorgio Pinot Grigio £15.75  
*Veneto, Italy* 2 175ml £3.95  
 A Pinot Grigio which actually delivers and is created for us by the now famous Pasqua family. Clean, crisp with loads of flavour all the way from Venezia. 250ml £5.35
3. Domaine de la Baume "Elisabeth" Viognier £17.95  
*IGP D'Oc, France* 2  
 Excellent wine with a very aromatic nose which is dominated by dried fruits and apricots, a hint of citrus even candied orange. The aromatic sensation then continues onto the palate. Very pleasant in the mouth, light and silky with a hint of spice.
4. 770 Miles Chardonnay £16.50  
*Central Valley, California* 1 175ml £4.20  
 This wine is pale yellow with golden highlights in colour. The nose is very aromatic with pineapple notes, white flowers and white pears, while the palate is lively and round, white pear hints and a wonderful sweetness on the finish with a touch of vanilla. 250ml £5.65
5. Riversdale Sauvignon Blanc £19.50  
*Marlborough, New Zealand* 1  
 This wonderful Sauvignon Blanc combines intense white peach and nectarine aromas with beautiful fresh fruit to provide a full palate and lingering finish.

6. Saint-Véran Maison Louis Latour £24.50  
*Mâconnais, France* 2  
 A classic Chardonnay from the world famous Burgundy region. Although less famous than its neighbour Pouilly-Fuissé, the two are similar in terms of relief, production techniques and even their actual taste/ fragrance. Charming floral aromas laced with honeysuckle.

## ROSÉ WINES

7. Liso Viente Garnacha Rosé £15.75  
*Navarra, Spain* 3 175ml £3.95  
 Think ripe strawberries, summer pudding and cherries fresh from the tree and you will be picturing the delights of this wine. 250ml £5.35
8. 770 Miles White Zinfandel £15.75  
*Central Valley, California* 4 175ml £3.95  
 This subtle pink Californian Zinfandel is very aromatic, with pronounced red fruit aromas which follow onto the palate. A light, rounded wine, fruity and fresh. 250ml £5.35

## RED WINES

9. Lomas Carrera Merlot £15.75  
*Chile* C 175ml £3.95  
 A wonderful ruby red Merlot which is soft and round, full of cherry and plum flavours and enhanced by elegant hints of cocoa. Just delicious and very approachable. 250ml £5.35
10. The Landings Shiraz Cabernet £15.75  
*South Eastern Australia* C 175ml £3.95  
 Two grape varieties which were made for each other with the Cab delivering back bone and cassis fruit while the Shiraz throws in bags of sweet plummy notes and a tantalising hint of spice. 250ml £5.35
11. Pablo Cortez Malbec £16.50  
*Mendoza, Argentina* C 175ml £4.20  
 A vibrant red with violet tones with an aroma of delicate and harmonious mixture of berries, plum marmalade and cherries while on the palate, an intense medium bodied wine with sweet and round tannins and a persistent finish. 250ml £5.65
12. Maximo Tempranillo £16.50  
*Tierra de Castillo, Spain* B 175ml £4.20  
 'A Rioja style wine, a real gem' - Tim Nortje, Wine buyer. James Pettit Wine Merchants. 250ml £5.65  
 This red wine has a ripe cherry red colour. Its aromas are of plums and red berries with hints of tobacco and vanilla. In the mouth it is alive, velvety and with sweet smooth tannins. The taste that stays in our palate is of red fruits with hints of liquorice and mint.
13. Château Lavison £19.50  
*Entre-Deux-Mers, Bordeaux, France* B  
 This is a warm medium bodied red from Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon. A traditional classic Claret.



EL COTO DE RIOJA

14. El Coto De Imaz Reserva £24.50  
*Rioja Alta, Spain* C  
 100% Tempranillo from Rioja Alta - Deep ruby red colour tinged with orange around the rim, revealing its age. Round and velvety on the palate. It invades the palate with persistent notes of red berry fruit and vanilla nuances from the oak. Soft tannins and good acidity guaranteeing its continued good evolution in the cellar.
