LOCAL RULES

OUT OF BOUNDS Rule 27

- Beyond any boundary fence, hedge or line of white stakes.
- Beyond the white stakes to the left of the 3rd hole.
- Beyond the hedge to the right of the 6th hole.
- Beyond the fence to the left of the 8th hole.
- On or beyond the curb of the road at the back of the 9th green. The buggy park is in play and relief can be taken under Rule 24-2.
- The Clubhouse Wedding Garden and the patio beyond the fenced area.

OBSTRUCTIONS Rule 24

Stones in bunkers and blue stakes in water hazards are movable obstructions (Rule 24-1).

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS CLOSE TO THE PUTTING GREEN

Relief for interference by an immovable obstruction may be obtained under Rule 24-2. In addition, if a ball lies off the putting green but not in a hazard and an immovable obstruction on or within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole the player may take relief as follows: The ball must be lifted and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay that (a) is not nearer the hole, (b) avoids intervention and (c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green. The ball may be cleaned when lifted.

PROTECTION OF YOUNG TREES

If any staked or wrapped tree or any young tree less than two club-lengths in height interferes with a player's stance, or intended swing plane, relief must be taken under Rule 24-2b.

LATERAL WATER HAZARDS

Rule 26 All lakes and ditches on the course whether or not marked with red stakes and/or lines are lateral water hazards.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULE:

Match Play - Loss of Hole;
Stroke Play - Two Strokes.

DISTANCE-MEASURING DEVICES Rule 14-3

Devices capable of measuring distance only are permitted.

PUBLIC FOOTPATH

A public footpath marked by yellow "Rights of Way" arrows follows the hedge to the right of the 6th fairway from level with the bunkers up to the green. It runs behind and then to the right of the 4th tee and down the path to the 7th tee.

Just before the 7th tee it goes into the bushes to the left to the boundary.

Precedence **MUST** be given to walkers using the footpath as players could be held liable for any injury to individuals using the pathway.

DISTANCE MARKERS Green posts mark distances to the centre of the greens. Yellow tops 200 yards, white tops 150 yards and red tops 100 yards.


TEMPORARY LOCAL RULES
