**Lakes Course New Local Rules – Final Version – 18/12/2018**

**Temporary Local Rules**  
Temporary Local Rules from time to time in force are published on the Club Notice Boards.

**LOCAL RULES**

**Out Of Bounds Rule 18**

- Beyond any boundary fence or hedge. Beyond the line between the course-side edge of the white stakes at ground level:
  - to the right of the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> holes.
  - to the left of the 15<sup>th</sup> hole including the practice ground.
  - to the left on the 12<sup>th</sup> hole when playing the 18<sup>th</sup> hole.
- When playing the 18<sup>th</sup> hole, the wedding garden and patio beyond the fenced areas are OOB. A ball is also OOB when it lies on or beyond the path outside the clubhouse.
- When playing the 12<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> holes, the white OOB stakes are immovable obstructions. Relief may be taken under Rule 16.1b.

**Abnormal Course Conditions Rule 16**

- Relief may be taken from paths, drainage lines and vehicle ruts in the general area. (Rule 16.1b).
- In addition, if a ball lies off the putting green but not in a bunker or penalty area and a fixed sprinkler head or drain on or within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may obtain relief without penalty as follows: The ball must be lifted and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which a) is not nearer the hole, b) avoids such intervention and c) is not in a bunker or penalty area or on a putting green.
- Blue stakes denoting outlet pipes and wooden posts supporting lifebuoys are integral objects if a player's ball lies in the penalty area. If the ball lies in the general area they are immovable obstructions and relief may be taken under Rule 16.1b.

**Protection Of Young Trees**

If any staked or wrapped tree or any young tree less than two club-lengths in height interferes with a player's stance or intended swing plane, the player must take relief under Rule 16.1f.

**Penalty Areas Rule 17**

All lakes and ditches on the course whether or marked with red stakes and/or lines are red penalty areas. In addition to taking relief under Rule 17 the player may drop the ball on the opposite side of the penalty area which is the same distance from the hole as the estimated point where the original ball last crossed the edge of the penalty area. Exception: When playing the 11<sup>th</sup> hole, other tee shots played from the Red tee, there is a Mandatory Drop Zone in front of the second fairway for any balls entering that lake at any point. N.B. The bridges over the ditch approaching the green are an integral part of the course. The ball may be played as it lies or the player may take relief under Rule 17.1d.

**Abnormal Course Condition – No Play Zones**

Plantation areas are defined by orange-topped brown posts. Relief must be taken from interference from these no play zones under Rule 16.1f.

**Penalty For Breach Of Local Rule**

Match Play – Loss of Hole.  
Stroke Play – General Penalty.

**Public Footpath**

A public footpath marked by yellow Rights of Way arrows crosses the Lakes Course: along the left side of the 13<sup>th</sup> hole, practice ground and 16<sup>th</sup> hole between the 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> tees, across the 3<sup>rd</sup> fairway and following the hedge up to the right of the 11<sup>th</sup> tee. It then crosses the 9-hole course between tees and greens to the boundary. It also passes behind the 9<sup>th</sup> green before following the right side of the 4<sup>th</sup> hole.

Precedence MUST be given to walkers using the footpath as players could be held liable for any injury to individuals using it.

**Distance Markers**

Discs in the fairways mark distances to the centre of the greens. White discs 200 Yards, yellow discs 100 Yards and red discs 100 Yards.

ALL MEMBERS AND GUESTS MUST RETAIN THEIR RECEIPT THAT WAS ISSUED AT RECEPTION/THE SHOP. FAILURE TO PRODUCE IT ON REQUEST COULD RESULT IN EJECTION FROM THE COURSE.
